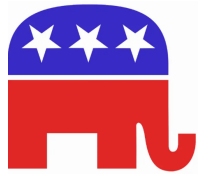

Asked members to write Op-Eds to have an organized voice; and suggested having Newsletter to send information instead of emails.

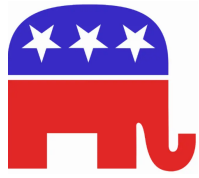
Terri Fowler - Election Integrity

Announcements:

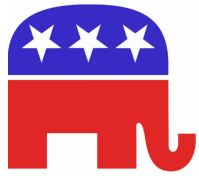
